

You can help to build our capacity by supporting the foundation of every performance – the backstage team.



From captivating WASO in Schools performances, that often mark a child's first orchestral encounter, to our prestigious Composition Project; where emerging composers are mentored, we pave accessible avenues for musical exploration and enjoyment.

Outreach

Our outreach initiatives share live music experiences with those who cannot ordinarily access our Orchestra on the mainstage. Music for the Ages delivers chamber ensembles directly to older adults who are unable to attend mainstage concerts. Connect fosters intimate and interactive concerts for adults living with disabilities, and the Hospital Orchestra Project (HOP) brings the healing power of live music to the wards of Perth Children's Hospital.

Integrating music into a child's developmental journey enhances their learning, including language skills, articulation, cognitive abilities, and improves self-confidence.

We champion the belief that learning music should be inclusive, reaching every corner of our community, and we are committed to nurturing the next wave of West Australian artistic talent.
