Some people want to quietly acknowledge the impact of the Orchestra on their lives; others want to know their gift will be recognised and shared with others. Many want to honour the lives of family and friends. What they all share is the desire to write the Orchestra into their life's story.



How to make WASO part of your will

There are many ways to make WASO part of your will, depending on your personal circumstances and wishes. We have included a selection of ways you can make a planned gift, also known as a bequest, in your will, including suggested wording. We encourage you to seek your own legal and financial advice and discuss your intentions with your family and friends.

Types of gifts to consider

Residuary The remainder of an estate after specific gifts have been disbursed.

Percentage A percentage of either the residue or the entire estate.

Pecuniary A specified dollar amount.

Specific Asset Includes real estate shares, bonds or other items of value.

Recommended wording

"I give to the West Australian Symphony Orchestra Pty Limited ABN 26 081 230 284 for the general purposes of the company [indicate amount as dollar or percentage, item or property] and declare that the receipt of the Company Secretary at the time shall be sufficient discharge of my executor's duty."

If you already have a will and do not wish to make major changes, you can make an amendment or codicil (an amendment to an existing will) to include WASO.
