Our heartfelt thank you goes out to everyone who donated towards our chair campaign and enabled such a significant upgrade to our musicians' experience on stage. The musicians are currently testing several prototypes and once the winning model is settled on, the 84 chairs will be ordered all the way from Germany. We are very much looking forward to

updating you all on the chairs' arrival and delivery in the next few months, and to 'introducing' you to your chairs with your or your loved one's names on the plaques.

We hope all our chair donors will be able to join us on Wednesday 22nd July for the 'Meet Your Chair' function, where you will have the opportunity to 'meet' the chair with your plaque attached on the Perth Concert Hall stage and enjoy a WASO rehearsal where our musicians will test out the new chairs! (You will receive an invite to this function closer to the date.)



Brian Pope – A Bassoonist's Story

It is a rare treat for an employee to meet their successors forty years after leaving a job. Last November, this very special event occurred for one of WASO's Emeritus musicians, ex- Principal Bassoon, Brian Pope.

After selection as Principal Bassoon in the first Australian Youth Orchestra, and then joining the ABC's Tasmanian Symphony Orchestra, Brian became an integral member of WASO, from 1959 until the late 70s.

Whilst at WASO, Brian made a significant contribution to the West Australian music industry, serving as a founding member of the WASO Players Association, as well as President of the WA Musicians' Union for many years.

During this time, Brian adopted the 'bassoon spike' in place of the neck strap to support the instrument. Brian wondered why it is not adopted more often by orchestral bassoonists as he found it a comfortable work posture. Cellists have their spike so why not the bassoonists!

Since Brian retired from his position at WASO almost forty years ago, he completed a BA (Hons) and an M.Phil in History at Murdoch University. He is an Honorary Associate of the WA Museum in the History Department with a particular interest in the philatelic holdings.

Last year, Brian's family decided to make use of the opportunity to support the purchase of an orchestral chair to celebrate the occasion of Brian's 87th birthday. To help celebrate his birthday and in honour of his association with the Orchestra, Brian attended a WASO rehearsal and was hosted by the current WASO bassoon section.

All present were thrilled to have the chance to host Brian and to share stories from WASO of old, as well as the Orchestra in recent times.
