All the glorious Proms staples are included: Wood's *Fantasia on British Sea Songs* is featured as well as Elgar's *Land of Hope and Glory*. And no Proms concert would be complete without a rousing rendition of Parry's stirring *Jerusalem* and *The Thunderbirds March*!

But it's not just a night of British patriotism - *The Last Night at the Proms* is a classical music spectacular that will appeal to audience members of all persuasions. Australia's favourite 'Master of Musical Ceremonies' Guy Noble hosts this last-night 'Hurrah' which will be filled with popular classics. Guy is well-known to Western Australian audiences as a conductor and all-round musical entertainer who has a long association with WASO and Proms concerts.













Australia's most highly-awarded soprano, Emma Matthews, will join Guy on stage for The Last Night at the Proms. Emma is a Principal Artist with Opera Australia and recently took up the position of Senior Lecturer and Head of Opera Studies at the Western Australian Academy of Performing Arts. However, it is her British heritage that will come to the fore as she leads the audience through patriotic anthems like Rule Britannia!
