

WASO gives the gift of music to Crescendo Kids

The joy of music and pride achieved by mastering a musical instrument is something that should be accessible to all.

Inspired by the Venezuelan social action music program El Sistema, and now in its fourth year, West Australian Symphony Orchestra's Crescendo is a one of a kind program delivering free, ongoing musical education in schools.

Weekly music lessons are provided to all students from Pre-Primary to Year Four at two Kwinana Primary schools. Starting as a vocal based program in the first two years, before moving on to string instruments; students play in ensembles and are able to take instruments home to practice.

According to ABC News, schools have reported higher NAPLAN results and better social and emotional wellbeing among students since becoming involved in the Crescendo program.

The Crescendo program is supported by Tianqi Lithium, and uses music to create a sense of togetherness, teaching the children to listen to and respect each other. In 2018 Tianqi increased their support to enable WASO to take the Education Chamber Orchestra (EChO) into the schools for a special performance increasing accessibility with all year groups able to attend.
